The North of 60 Food Drive.

The North of 60 Food Drive is a project organized by participating Saint Vincent de Paul groups in York Region to help our Canadian brothers and sisters in Taloyoak, Nunavut. Our St. Padre Pio Conference is seeking your assistance in collecting specific food items that will help to support the Inuit in the Canadian Far North.

Taloyoak has no roads beyond the immediate community and it is impossible to grow crops there. This makes food prices very high. In fact, groceries cost 4-5 times higher than here in York Region.

If you can help, we are collecting the following items: flour, sugar, salt, peanut butter, jam, oatmeal, rice, pasta, canned luncheon meats, cooking oil and lard. <u>All food donations must be dropped off by</u>

the weekend of June 24 and 25, 2023. The food will then be dropped off at a central location and loaded into a sea container. The container will be driven to Port of Montreal and then loaded onto the annual supply ship for Nunavut. We thank you ask for prayers for the Inuit community of Taloyoak.
