Canada Day - On Thursday, July 1, there will be a special Mass for Canada Day at 10:00am. The church will close after the Mass and there will NOT be an Italian Mass in the evening.

**Baptism** – We offer our congratulations to the parents of the children baptized last weekend:

There will be a baptismal preparation class on Monday, June 28, 2021 at 7:30pm, at the church, for the parents and godparents of the children being baptized in July.

First Friday – Friday, July 2 is the first Friday of the Month. Mass will be celebrated at 9:00am only, with Benediction and Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament after the Mass. Because this day is considered part of the holiday weekend, there will NOT be an evening Mass and the church will close after Benediction.

**Reopening of Churches** – The churches have now reopened at 15% capacity. Daily Masses and the weekend Masses have resumed. The 15% capacity means that once the two centre sets of pews have been filled, that is full capacity, and no one else may enter the church, by law. We hope that, eventually, church capacity will increase as we slowly get back to normal.

**Confessions** – have now returned to their normal times on Saturday from 4:00pm to 4:30pm and on Thursday evenings from 6:30pm to 7:00pm.

**Confirmations** – Since the schools are not reopening until September, the July dates for Confirmations will be maintained. There will be four Confirmation Masses during the week of July 5<sup>th</sup> for the classes of 2020. Parents should have already received notice of their particular date and time.
