The four classes from 2020 (one class from St. Padre Pio school and three classes from St. Stephen School)will have their Confirmations the week of July 5th. The Confirmation classes for 2021, 10 in all, will have to wait until the Fall. Parents should have already received notices about the new dates. This is all beyond our control and we are trying to do our best for our young people.
