Thurs - 6:30 to 7:00 p.m. (Italian) Sat - 4:00 p.m. - 4:30 p.m. Any other time by appointment.


COMMUNION FOR THE SICK:

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

Pentecost - The Easter season concludes with Pentecost Sunday when we commemorate the gift of the Holy Spirit to the apostles, the beginnings of the Church and the start of its mission to bring the Good news to all people and nations. We recognize and celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit as the life-principle of the Church. For without the Holy Spirit in our lives, God seems very far away, Jesus stays in the past, and the gospel is a dead letter, the Church simply an organization, authority becomes a matter of domination, mission a matter of propaganda, the liturgy no more than an evocation, Christian living a slave morality. But with the Holy Spirit the cosmos is resurrected and groans with the birth-pangs of the Kingdom, the risen Christ is here, the gospel is the power of life, the Church shows forth the life of the Trinity, authority is a liberating service, mission is a Pentecost, the liturgy is both memorial and anticipation, and human action is deified.

The Gifts of the Holy Spirit

Bless me with the KNOWLEDGE to know right from wrong,

FORTITUDE to stand up and be strong UNDERSTANDING to follow God's way, PIETY to worship and pray,

COUNSEL to enlighten and guide me, WISDOM TO feel your presence beside me, And FEAR OF THE LORD to be always awed by the mighty wonders of our God!

The Easter Candle –is lit at all Masses today. After the celebration of Pentecost, it is placed by the baptismal font where it is displayed with due honour. It is used during the celebration of baptism, and the candles of the newly baptized are lighted from it. The Easter Candle is also used in funeral Masses, standing near the casket as a symbol of the presence of the Risen Christ.

Covid Retrictions – have now been extended to at least June 2. Church attendance is restricted to 10 people. Masses will continue to be temporarily cancelled. The church is open for private prayer during the normal times. The 10: 30am Mass on Sunday will continue to be livestreamed on the parish website: <u>www.stpp.church</u>. On Saturdays, there will be confessions from 4: 30pm to 5:00pm followed by Communion Services from 5:00pm to 6:00pm. On Sunday, there will be Communion Srvices from 11: 30 am to 1:00pm, with 10 people at a time. We will continue to update you as the situation evolves. You can check on our website or on Instagram.

Confirmations – The Confirmations that were scheduled from May 25 to June 2 will have to be rescheduled again. Parents should have already received notice about the new dates. The Confirmations already scheduled from June 4th to June 18 will continue as planned. But all of these dates should be considered as tentative in case Covid restrictions are extended again. We are still hoping to have all the Confirmations completed before the end of the school year.
