Day 3: Blessed Spirit of *Counsel*, enlighten and guide me in all my ways, that I may always know and do Your holy Will. Make me prudent and courageous.

Day 4: Blessed Spirit of *Fortitude*, give me help in overcoming obstacles in my life and the courage to stand up for justice and truth in every situation.

Day 5: Blessed Spirit of *Knowledge*, help me to know good from evil. Teach me to do what is right in the sight of God. Give me clear vision and firmness in decision
