Her children suffer from malnutrition because she earns just \$5 per day selling household items at an outdoor market. A local charity reached out to Canadian Food for Children (CFFC), a ShareLife-funded agency. CFFC began sending shipments to her community that include food, clothing, and toys. Irma is relieved to receive ongoing support to help her feed her family. **The third and final collection for ShareLife will take place next weekend.**

Handicapped Parking – Near the side entrance to the church, on the left side, there are 4 parking spots, two of which are handicapped parking. Some people come early for church and immediately take the two handicapped parking spots, to which they are entitled, leaving the other two regular spots empty. If they were to take the regular spots instead (it's only difference of a few feet), this would allow two more cars with handicapped parking stickers to park close to the side entrance. This would be a great courtesy, thus allowing four cars with handicapped stickers, instead of only two, to park near the entrance.

Sacraments for 2022 – Registration: Teaching preparation for the sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation for 2022 will begin shortly. Tentative dates for the actual celebrations of these sacraments will be given in November. But registrations will begin now. If your child attends one of the Catholic schools in our parish, a letter and registration form have already been sent home. If you child attends one of the public or private schools, you must go to the parish website, www.stpp.church, for registration information.
