Change in Time – Next weekend our clocks "fall back" one hour on Sunday, Nov. 7 at 2:00am. This keeps us in line with the rest of North America

All Saints – All Saints' Day commemorates all the saints of the Church, both known and unknown, who have attained heaven. The old term for this day is All Hallows' Day, 'hallow' being another word for 'saint.' The evening before All Hallows' Day was called All Hallows' Eve and then shortened to Halloween. Originally it was a day of preparation for All Hallows' Day or All Saints Day, but has since lost its religious connection. It is now celebrated as a secular day with costumes and decorations commonly associated with death. All Soul's Day follows on Nov. 2, which is a day of prayer and remembrance for all the Faithful Departed.

All Soul's Day – There will be two Masses for All Souls' Day at 9:00am and 7pm.

All Souls Envelopes – Because of the pandemic the Book of Life containing all the names of our deceased relatives and friends will not be put out. So, you will not be able to write in any new names this year. However, there will be a wooden box at the front where you can drop an 'All Souls' envelopes with the

name of your loved ones who have passed away. The envelopes are available in the Narthex of the church

First Friday – Friday, Nov. 5th is the First Friday of the month. Mass will be celebrated at 9am and 7pm. Benediction and Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will take place after the morning Mass.

The Knights of Columbus – will have their General Meeting on Monday, November 1st, at 7:00pm in the Narthex of the church. There is no requirement for proof of vaccination for the meeting.

Offertory Envelopes for 2022 – will be available shortly. We are determining the safest way for our parishioners to be able to pick them up.

Canadian Food for Children – The CWL of St. Padre Pio is having a food drive for The Canadian Food for Children the weeks of Oct.30/31 and Nov. 6/7 and 13/14.
