<u>Indigenous Healing & Reconciliation Fund</u> Collection – October 1/2, 2022

Catholics throughout the Archdiocese of Toronto are invited to participate in the collection being held the weekend of October 1/2 to support the Indigenous Healing & Reconciliation Fund. The collection is a national grassroots effort to assist healing and reconciliation with Indigenous Peoples of This Land. The fund was the result of a \$30 million financial commitment made by the Canadian Bishops in September 2021.

Funds will support culture and language revitalization, education and community building, healing and reconciliation for communities and families and dialogue involving Indigenous elders, spiritual leaders and youth with a focus on Indigenous spirituality and culture.

THE POWER OF THE CROSS: A MUSICALLY IMMERSED PASSION PLAY

The Parish of St. Padre Pio is excited to announce that this year we will be creating a Passion Play that will also act as a major fundraising event for the church. We are looking for volunteers to perform, people to help behind the scenes and sponsors.

Held on the evening of Palm Sunday (**Sunday**, **April 2**, **2023**, **7:30 PM)**, at St. Padre Pio Church, the production will be a beautiful way to start Holy Week. A traditional part of Lent, the Passion Play is steeped in history, faith and devotion and brings the Gospel readings to life. Passion plays are a dramatic source of inspiration for Catholics, a way to reflect on the events most central to our faith, and to understand them at a deeper level. Historically, they have also been used to bring community together. This will be the aim of this project. As well, the Passion Play will act as a major fundraiser for the church.

Our Passion Play, entitled **The Power of The Cross**, will depict how Christ's sacrifice became a love story - our salvation story - and inevitably the most important part of our religious lives. Each scene will include beautiful and poignant music.

This St. Padre Pio Parish Community's inaugural performance of the Passion of Jesus Christ will bring traditional and contemporary approaches to the reenactment of our salvation story. A thoughtfully conceived script combining Gospel readings, liturgical and praise and worship music, along with symbolic and thematic components will be created. Theatrical elements like sound, lighting, props, set and costuming will be utilized to bring the Passion story to life. Community will come together to share in the Easter story, and participate in this creative fundraising event, aimed at assisting in our Parish needs and bringing more people into our beautiful parish of St. Padre Pio.
