FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Generation Life.

If any begin to give themselves to God, there are so many to criticize them that they need to seek companionship to defend themselves until they are so strong that it is no longer a burden for them to suffer this criticism. — St. Teresa of Avila

Why is it that when we are trying to lift ourselves up, there are so many trying to drag us down? When I began taking faith seriously I would hear it from my own family: "Are you going to Church *again*? Do you have to go *every* Sunday? Surely you don't actually *believe* in all that?"

This is the common experience. It was the same in St. Augustine's time: "For to love this world is to break faith with God, yet men applaud and are ashamed to be otherwise." It was the same 1400 years later for Bl. John Henry Newman: "Men do not begin by intending to dishonor God; but they are afraid of the ridicule of others; they are ashamed of appearing religious; and thus they are led to appear worse than they really are."

Indeed, we are often ashamed of appearing religious, of appearing "good." We are teased and mocked and so we give in. Like Peter we say, "I do not know the man!" If only, like Peter, we could also weep over our betrayal.

It is easy to become dismayed at our own weakness and inconstancy. But God is speaking to us, just as he spoke to the great prophet Jeremiah: "Do not be dismayed. Behold, I make you this day a fortified city, an iron pillar, and bronze walls. They will fight against you but they shall not prevail against you, for I am with you, says the Lord."

Keep in mind Newton's third law: for every action there is an equal and opposite reaction. This means that when you feel someone dragging you *down*, you are at the same time pulling them *up*. So keep a firm hold and don't let go.

Still, it comes as a welcome relief when, instead of being weighed down, you get a boost up. Our parish was fortunate to be able to host a team of young people from *Generation Life*. The team gave a series of talks at St. Thomas Aquinas High School and to our grade eight students of St. Paul's and Holy Family schools.

Chad and Sarah — two amazing young Catholics — offered a faith-filled and uplifting a message on life and love. Our modern commercialized "youth culture" has a lot to say about sex — it is time that our teens heard something about Love. And they got that from *Generation Life*. A simple message, but profound. Because it comes right from the heart of the Gospel.

We are constantly inundated by so much that is negative and life-denying, it is good to hear something positive and life-affirming. And also challenging. As Pope John Paul II said: "The time has come to re-propose the high standard of Christian living." I am so grateful for *Generation Life*, for them helping our young people see that this high standard is also a great adventure: that to live fully we must love fully.
