FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Mother Angelica, 1923—2016.

How does God look after his Church in difficult times? By raising up prophets and saints.

When the time comes to write the history of the post-Vatican II Catholic Church, Mother Angelica will get her own chapter. You cannot understand the Church today without knowing about Mother Angelica and her "network of miracles." This simple nun, with no resources other than her inborn spunk and her absolute trust in God, founded the Eternal World Television Network (EWTN), the world's largest religious media network. Pope John Paul II recognized the vital importance of Mother's work for the new evangelization. "EWTN," he said, "is the key to restoring the Roman Catholic Church in America."

Mother Angelica was a "simple" nun only in the sense that she came from an immigrant working-class background and never had any extensive education. Born Rita Rizzo in 1923 in Canton, Ohio, she took the name Angelica when she entered the Poor Clare convent in 1944 at the age of 21. In 1962, with a handful of sisters, Angelica founded a new convent in Birmingham, Alabama — Our Lady of the Angels Monastery.

Mother Angelica's plan was to live a simple life of prayer, hidden from the world, but God had other plans. She began giving impromptu talks on the Bible to small groups of women. Soon these talks were being recorded and distributed on audio cassette. A short weekly broadcast on local radio followed, and then she began video-taping the talks for a Christian satellite network.

In 1981 Mother Angelica visited a Chicago television studio and thought, "I need to get one of these!" The fact that she did not have any money did not stop her. She converted the convent garage into a studio, ordered a satellite dish and trusted in God to take care of the rest.

It wasn't easy — there was plenty of drama as she fought to get EWTN on the air and to keep it going. There was plenty of opposition, both from outside and inside the Church. Not everyone was happy with her brand of Catholicism — which came straight out of the Baltimore Catechism — which came straight out of the Baltimore Catechism. This no-nonsense nun was not afraid of putting even Bishops in their place if they were out of line.

Mother later moved her community to Hanceville and built the Shrine of the Most Blessed Sacrament. When asked how she knew that this is what God wanted, she answered: "If I say the Lord spoke to me and wanted me to build this building and nothing ever happened and it turned out to be a shack — obviously it wasn't the Lord. I mean, the test is not believing me; the test is that *it happened!*"

For her whole life, Mother Angelica lived with illness and pain. In 2001, she suffered a stroke which left her partly paralyzed. This marked the beginning of the last phase of her life, being cared for by her devoted daughters. Mother Angelica died at the age of 92 this Easter Sunday.

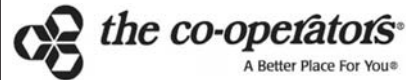
