FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Adult faith formation — a personal responsibility.

Maturity is about assuming responsibility. Most people only fully realize what it is to be an adult when they have their first child and they take on all the responsibilities that go along with that life-changing event. In our present culture, that moment of maturity is being put off to later and later in life. Adolescence is prolonged as much as possible. It is the "Peter Pan syndrome":

I won't grow up / I don't want to wear a tie
Or a serious expression / in the middle of July
And if it means I must prepare /
to shoulder burdens with a worried air
I won't grow up / not me!

If we are to be fully human we need to grow up and become adults. St. Paul writes to the Corinthians: "When I was a child, I spoke like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child; when I became a man, I gave up childish ways."

At some point in our lives we need to give up childish ways in matters of faith. Sadly, some people never reach this point. For the first part of their lives they are taken to Church by their parents, and later on they are taken to Church by their spouse. In matters of faith, they must constantly be led by the hand. They never learn to walk on their own. Spiritually, they remain toddlers.

Each of us is responsible for his own faith. You alone are responsible for your relationship with God. If you don't save your own soul, nobody else is going to do it for you.

Once, I was giving a presentation on the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* to a class of adults. One of the participants questioned the need: "Shouldn't we be told all this in the homily on Sunday?" The answer is "No." A homily is not a catechism lesson, and some topics of grave importance taught in the *Catechism* are not appropriate for a congregation that includes children.

Every Catholic who is able to read the *Catechism* has an obligation to read the *Catechism*. For others, there is the *Youth Catechism*. For children, I suggest that parents go back to the old *Penny Catechism*. My father knew the children's *Catechism* by heart — because he taught it to all six of his children.

My own spiritual life was given an immense boost when I came across some writings of Cardinal Newman in the public library. It was an eye-opener. It was my introduction to mature Christian faith. And I realized that if I was going to continue to grow in faith, I would have to take responsibility for my faith. In addition to reading the Catholic spiritual classics, this also meant joining a Catholic Bible-study group and getting involved in parish ministry — rubbing shoulders with other committed Catholics.

At the start of this New Year let us resolve to grow to "mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; so that we may no longer be children."
