#### FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Faith is strengthened by way of the heart.

Cardinal Robert Sarah was born in 1945 in a small rural village in Guinea, West Africa. At the age of thirty-four he was made the Archbishop of Conakry, Guinea. Pope John Paul II later called him to Rome as Secretary of the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples. Pope Francis appointed him head of the Congregation for Divine Worship, one of the top posts in the Vatican.

Cardinal Sarah's book, *God or Nothing*, is by far the best Catholic book published in 2015. In this book, Cardinal Sarah recounts his early life in Guinea, his experiences as a young man studying for the priesthood, and the challenges facing an Archbishop in the capital of a country ruled by a ruthless Marxist dictator. Cardinal Sarah also speaks frankly about the present state of the world and the Catholic Church. A man of great wisdom born of hard-won experience and also a man of profound faith, Cardinal Sarah is not afraid to acknowledge the serious problems of our modern times, while looking forward in hope.

Commenting on the New Evangelization, which was proposed by Pope John Paul II and promoted by Pope Benedict and Pope Francis, Cardinal Sarah wrote:

In the current situation, how can we help people to rediscover the faith? We cannot say who Christ is by means of intellectual concepts; what is needed is an experience that is both spiritual and "physical" at the same time.

To prepare for the new evangelization Pope John Paul II decided to issue a Catechism of the Catholic Church, entrusting the project to Cardinal Joseph Ratzinger (later to become Pope Benedict XVI) as editor-in-chief. The entire doctrine of the Church is found in this document. And we have an urgent obligation, says St. Athanasius, to study "the ancient tradition, teaching, and faith of the Catholic Church, which was revealed by the Lord, proclaimed by the Apostles, and guarded by the Fathers. For upon this faith the Church is built, and if anyone were to lapse from it, he would no longer be Christian either in fact or in name."

But the faith is strengthened by way of the heart, through a personal encounter with and experience of Jesus. Every day we must once again choose Christ as our guide, our light and our hope. Baptism demands some sort of daily actualization. I am not afraid to recall that spiritual combat is first of all a war against the evil that is within us. The Church is reformed when the baptized march more resolutely toward holiness, allowing themselves to be recreated in the likeness of God, by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Cardinal Sarah now has a new book coming out: *The Strength of Silence*. According to the early reviews, it looks like it may be the best Catholic book of 2017.
