FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

A new springtime and the new evangelization.

Pope Francis has now returned from his visit to Africa where he has experienced first-hand the vitality of the Catholic Church on that continent, which is in sharp contrast to the dismal state of the Church in the West.

Cardinal Robert Sarah, in his recently published book *God or Nothing*, says:

In Europe, we have the impression that Catholicism is now near its last gasp. It is enough however to spend a week at the *Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples* to understand that, on the contrary, the Church has an extraordinary vitality. We are experiencing a "new springtime of Christianity," as John Paul II liked to say. In 1900 there were two million African Catholics; today there are 185 million.

Cardinal Sarah was formerly was formerly the Bishop of Conakry in Guinea on the west coast of Africa, serving at the time when the people of that country were suffering extreme repression under a Marxist dictatorship. He is now the head of the *Congregation for Divine Worship*, one of the most important positions in the Church.

Cardinal Sarah is keenly aware that while the Church is growing in Africa and Asia, it is dying in Europe and North America, which have now become mission territories.

I think that the immense economic, military, technological, and media influence of a godless West could be a disaster for the world. if the West does not convert to Christ, it could end up making the whole world pagan; the philosophy of unbelief feverishly seeks followers in new parts of the globe. In this sense, we are facing an atheism that is proselytizing more and more. The pagan culture is determined to extend the domain of its struggle against God. In order to bring about their rebirth, the former countries of the old Christian tradition need to re-energize by embarking on a new evangelization.

Indeed, when we observe today the many deficiencies of faith, the eclipse of the sense of God and man, the lack of real familiarity with the teaching of Jesus Christ, the detachment of some countries from their Christian roots, and what John Paul II called a "silent apostasy," it is urgent to think about a new evangelization. This movement presupposes that we go beyond mere theoretical knowledge of the Word of God; we must rediscover personal contact with Jesus.

Many circumstances and deep motives, or the people around us, may have led us to follow Jesus. Then comes the moment of maturity, when only our personal experience of Christ guides us. This personal encounter is decisive for the rest of our lives.

As the title of his books says: "God or nothing."
