#### FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

*Deus absconditus* — is God hiding?

As strange as it seems, my return to the Catholic faith of my childhood was greatly assisted by two fervent atheists.

The first was Charles Templeton, a former Billy-Graham-style Protestant evangelist, who wrote a book called *Farewell to God: My Reasons for Rejecting the Christian Faith*. His description of how we human beings are simply the mindless product of purposeless evolution struck me as being so obviously self-refuting that I began to have serious doubts about my own agnosticism.

The other was Stephen Hawking, the brilliant theoretical physicist who wrote *A Brief History of Time*. He explored such questions as: "How did the universe begin? What made its start possible? Is the universe unending, or are there boundaries?" Reading this book was like looking at a flashing neon sign saying "GOD!"

These two intelligent and articulate authors made me realize what St. Augustine discovered long ago:

Some people, in order to discover God, read books. But there is a great book: the very appearance of created things. Look above you! Look below you! Note it. Read it. God, whom you would discover, never wrote that book with ink; instead he set before your eyes the things he had made. Can you ask for a louder voice than that? Why, heaven and earth shout to you: "God made me!"

Creation points beyond itself to the creator. And yes, there are people, even some endowed with great natural intelligence, who look at the miracle of creation and see nothing except blind matter. Like the writer of the book of Ecclesiastes, they gaze at the universe and shout out: "Vanity of vanities! — Meaningless! Meaningless! Utterly meaningless! Everything is meaningless."

It is surprising how so many people can avoid seeing what seems so obvious, what the prophet Isaiah proclaimed:

For thus says the Lord, he who created the heavens, he who fashioned and made the earth. He founded it. He did not create it to be empty, but formed it to be inhabited. "I am the Lord and there is no other. I have not spoken in secret, from somewhere in a land of darkness. I have not said to Jacob's descendants: seek me in vain. Turn to me and be saved all you ends of the earth. For I am God, and there is no other."

Our very striving to understand the universe, to know our place in it, testifies to the *meaningfulness* of creation. The very act of intellect by which Templeton and Hawking so vehemently reject God, this act of intellect itself testifies to God who has endowed them with the gift of intellect. Cardinal Newman said that he was as sure of the existence of God as he was of the existence of his own hands and feet. I know exactly what he meant. So how is it possible that for so many people today — our family, friends and neighbors — God remains a *deus absconditus*, a hidden God?




