FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Septuagesima Sunday

According to the traditional calendar, today is the first of three specially designated Sundays leading up to the start of Lent. Traditionally this pre-Lent season had a semi-penitential character: the liturgical color was purple; the *Gloria* and *Alleluia* were not sung; fasting, however, did not begin until Ash Wednesday. The revised calendar, which came into use after the Second Vatican Council, jumps abruptly from Ordinary Time to Lent without any transition. However, if we are going to benefit spiritually from our observances of Lent, it is absolutely essential that we be properly prepared.

The season of Lent is especially a time of prayer, fasting and alms-giving. The Gospel reading for Ash Wednesday is from Matthew, chapter 6, where Jesus' teaching is clear: "When you give alms ... When you pray ... When you fast ..." Jesus does not say "If"; he says "When." These practices are not optional. These are things we should be doing throughout the year, but especially during the upcoming season of Lent.

Lent is a time when God generously wants to pour his graces upon us in abundance. We need to open our hearts to receive them. As St Augustine says: "Suppose you are going to fill some container, and you know you will be given a large amount, then you set about enlarging the container. Why? Because you know the quantity you will have to put in it and your eyes tell you there is not enough room. By expanding it, therefore, you increase the capacity of the container." Lent is a time for expanding our capacity.

Above all, let us make this coming Lent a time of more frequent and fervent prayer. Pope John Paul II said: "The Christian life is distinguished above all in the art of prayer. Prayer cannot be taken for granted. We have to learn to pray. Prayer develops that conversation with Christ which makes us his intimate friends."

Every Friday evening during Lent we pray the Stations of the Cross. I cannot imagine Lent without the Stations, and yet most families have *never* come to Church to pray the Stations! God has an abundance of graces to give but few are showing up to receive them. If you are not able to pray the Stations with the parish, you can still pray them at home — the family is the "domestic church."

If you are not praying the Rosary, Lent is the time to start and to establish this good habit. This year marks the 100^{th} anniversary of Fatima. Our Lady implores us to "pray the Rosary daily." If you have not made a Consecration to Jesus through Mary, consider doing that now, beginning on February 20^{th} — see the notice in this bulletin.

Carefully consider your program for Lent. It should be difficult, a real challenge, but possible and practical. Work it out now and write it down. Make a firm resolution. Make it your promise to God. Be generous. God will not be outdone in generosity.
