**FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:**

*Nove sed non nova.*

Since this is the last bulletin before the summer break, I want to return to a topic that I have written about many times before — the clear principle that the doctrine of the Catholic Church does not change and cannot be changed.

At every Mass, we pray for Pope Francis and Cardinal Collins and “all those who, holding to the truth, pass on the Catholic and Apostolic faith.” The word “Catholic” comes from the Greek *katholicos* which means universal. “Apostolic” means that it has been handed down from the first Apostles, the companions of Jesus.

St. Irenaeus, second-century Bishop of Lyons, who was a student of St. Polycarp, who was in turn a student of St. John the Evangelist, explained it like this:

The Church, which has spread everywhere, even to the ends of the earth, received the faith from the Apostles and now preserves it carefully. Having one soul and one heart, the Church holds this faith, preaches and teaches it consistently as though by a single voice. For though there are different languages, there is but one Tradition.

The faith and the tradition of the Churches founded in Germany are no different from those founded among the Spanish and the Celts, in the East, in Egypt, in Libya and elsewhere in the Mediterranean world. Just as the sun is one and the same the world over, so also does the Church’s preaching shine everywhere to enlighten men who want to come to a knowledge of the truth.

Now of those who speak with authority in the churches, no preacher however forceful will utter anything different — for no one above the Master — nor will a less forceful preacher diminish what has been handed down. Since our faith is everywhere and always the same, no one can either add to it or subtract from it.

This passage is read by every priest each year in the Liturgy of the Hours. It is also quoted in the Catechism of the Catholic Church (no. 173–174).

Is there then to be no development of doctrine? St. Vincent of Lerins, in the fifth century, answers: “Yes. But it must truly be *development* of the faith, not *alteration* of the faith. What was formerly believed, though not perfectly apprehended, may be more clearly explained. Yet we continue to teach the same truths which we have learned.”

Pope John XXIII, in his address at the opening of the Second Vatican Council quoted St. Vincent: “*Nove sed non nova* — in a new way, but not new things.”

Truth does not change. What was true for St. John and St. Irenaeus continues to be true now for you and me. It will be true for our great-grandchildren and their great-grandchildren. Our job is to understand it more fully, to teach it more clearly and to live it more faithfully.

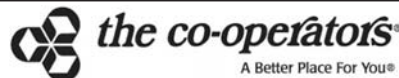
