FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

An invitation to an encounter with Jesus Christ.

Gaudium Evangelii — "The Joy of the Gospel" — was Pope Francis' first major teaching document. It was his summary and reflections on the deliberations of the Synod of Bishops on the New Evangelization. It came out only four months ago yet it seems, as they say in Latin, *quasi non fuit* — as if it had never been, a mere "flash in the pan."

Pope Francis himself says: "I am aware that nowadays documents do not arouse the same interest as in the past *and they are quickly forgotten*. Nevertheless, I want to emphasize that what I am trying to express here has programmatic significance and important consequences. I hope that all communities will devote the necessary effort to advancing along the path of pastoral and missionary conversion which cannot leave things as they presently are."

The program that Pope Francis is proposing is the same that was laid out by Pope John Paul II at the beginning of the new millennium: "It is a program that already exists. It is found in the Gospel and in the living Tradition. Ultimately, it has its center in Christ himself, who is to be known, loved and imitated. It is the same as ever. This program does not change with shifts of times and cultures. This program for all times is our program for the Third Millennium.... The time has come to re-propose wholeheartedly to everyone this *high standard of ordinary Christian living*. The whole life of the Christian community and of Christian families must lead in this direction."

This is simply what the Second Vatican Council called "the universal call to holiness." Frank Sheed wrote in his classic, *Theology and Sanity*: "The real job of the moment is to re-Christianize the world — beginning with ourselves, of course, but not postponing the rest of the world until our own Christianization is completed."

Another Latin saying is *Nemo dat quod non habet* — you can't give what you don't have. We can't evangelize — we can't share the riches of our life in Christ — unless we *are* alive in Christ. We first have to be evangelized before we can evangelize others. We have to be on fire with the love of Jesus if we are going to kindle a flame in others.

Back to Pope Francis: "It is impossible to persevere in fervent evangelization unless we are convinced from personal experience that it is not the same thing to have known Jesus as not to have known him, not the same thing to walk with him as to walk blindly, not the same thing to hear his word as not to know it, and not the same thing to contemplate him, to worship him, to find our peace in him, as not to. We know well that with Jesus life becomes richer and that with him it is easier to find meaning in everything."

At the beginning of the second millennium Pope Leo XIII said: "The greatest of all misfortunes is never to have known Jesus Christ." Conversely, the greatest of all treasures it to know him and to love him. This is the joy of living in Christ. This is the joy of the Gospel.
