
St. Paul the Apostle and Immaculate Conception Churches



FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

The most prophetic of modern apparitions.

One hundred years ago, on the thirteenth of May, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to three children at Fatima, Portugal. Our Lady told the children to return on the thirteenth day of each month. The final appearance was on the 13th October. A crowd of thousands gathered around the children to see what would happen — what they saw was the "miracle of the sun."

Over the last century, the story of Fatima has continued to attract much attention, both because of the miracle of the sun but also because of the "secrets." The *Congregation for the Doctrine of the Fai*th released the text of the "third secret" in 2000, saying:

Throughout history there have been supernatural apparitions and signs which go to the heart of human events and which, to the surprise of believers and non-believers alike, play their part in the unfolding of history. These manifestations can never contradict the content of faith, and must therefore have their focus in the core of Christ's proclamation: the Father's love which leads men and women to conversion and bestows the grace required to abandon oneself to him with filial devotion. This too is the message of Fatima which, with its urgent call to conversion and penance, draws us to the heart of the Gospel.

Fatima is undoubtedly the most prophetic of modern apparitions. The "secrets" refer especially to the frightening vision of hell, devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, the Second World War, and finally the prediction of the immense damage that Russia would do to humanity by abandoning the Christian faith and embracing Communist totalitarianism.

The message of Fatima is a message of both warning and encouragement for times of tribulation. It is above all a call to conversion. At a time when the anti-Christian forces of secularism were everywhere undermining the faith, it was an urgent appeal to all people to return to faith in God.

While the world as a whole did not heed the warning, the Catholic faithful embraced the message. The "Fatima prayer" was added to the Rosary: "O my Jesus, forgive us our sins. Save us from the fires of hell. Lead all souls to heaven, especially those most in need of thy mercy."

What I find especially moving in the story of Fatima is the behavior of the children. Despite intense pressure from their families and the clergy, they never changed their story. Even when the civil authorities put them in jail and threatened them with torture, the three children would not deny what they had seen.

That there have been many authentic apparitions is undeniable. Just as Jesus appeared to his disciples after his resurrection, and to St. Paul on the road to Damascus, so it is quite normal that his mother should appear to three shepherd children at Fatima.
