FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Total Consecration to Jesus Through Mary

"You say that you believe — act on it and that is faith."

— St. Augustine.

Too often our faith has more to do with our heads than with our hearts. It is a cold faith without any great affection or devotion. Sometimes it amounts to little else than trying to avoid the worse sins and making excuses for the lesser. We can be in a state of living a lukewarm faith without enthusiasm. Conversion then is not so much a matter of changing one's mind as it is of changing one's heart. Conversion often is simply becoming aware of the wonder of life, knowing that we are created in God's image and likeness, and being suitably grateful.

St. Louis de Montfort was an itinerant preacher in France in the 1700s. His mission was to rekindle the fire if love in hearts that had grown cold. He preached what he called the "surest, easiest, shortest, and the most perfect means" for becoming a saint: the Act of Consecration to Jesus through Mary (also called the Marian Consecration).

To "consecrate" something means to set it aside to be used only for holy things. In the Act of Consecration we consecrate ourselves to a life of grace and the pursuit of holiness. In this Act we invite the Holy Spirit to be in us as the life of our souls. We do this in a special way by uniting ourselves to Mary, she who is "full of grace", who, as the Mother of Jesus, is also the mother of all Christians.

As Fr. Michael Gaitley explains:

Marian consecration basically means giving Mary our full permission to complete her motherly task in us, which is to form us into other Christs. Thus, by consecrating ourselves to Mary, each of us is saying to her: "Mary, I want to be a saint. I know that you also want me to be a saint and that it's your God-given mission to form me into one. So, Mary, at this moment, on this day, I freely choose to give you my full permission to do your work in me, with your spouse, the Holy Spirit.

Pope John Paul II called his Marian Consecration the turning point in his life. When he became Pope, he took as his motto, *Totus tuus*, "Totally yours, (Mary)."

The preparation for the Act of Consecration traditionally is done over the course of 33 days, ending on one of the Marian feast days. I am inviting you to join me and other members of this parish as we begin our preparation on Tuesday, November 5th.

We will do the Act of Consecration on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception on Monday, December 9th at the 7:00 pm Mass.

We are all called to be saints. There are many ways to advance along this path. The Act of Consecration is one of them, and one strongly recommended by the Church. The hardest part of any journey is taking the first step. Life is about choice. Do we choose to be saints? What are we going to do to make it happen?


