
St. Paul the Apostle and Immaculate Conception Churches

FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

The holy souls in Purgatory.

Temporary punishments are suffered by some in this life only and by others after death. It is not to be doubted, though, that the dead can be helped by the prayers of Holy Church, and the Eucharistic Sacrifice, and alms distributed for the repose of their spirits; so that God may deal with them more mercifully than their sins have deserved. The whole Church, I mean, observes this tradition received from the Fathers, that prayers should be offered for those who died in the communion of the body and blood of Christ, whenever their names are mentioned at the Sacrifice in the usual place, and that it should be announced that the Sacrifice is offered for them.— St. Augustine.

The month of November is dedicated to prayer for the holy souls in Purgatory. The Church has always believed that souls must go through a state of purification after death. Although it seems lately to have been forgotten, this belief has never changed,. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that "all who die in God's grace, but still imperfectly purified, undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of Heaven" (CCC 1030).

One of the great treatises on Purgatory was dictated by St. Catherine of Genoa (1447-1510). According to St. Catherine, "the souls in Purgatory do not consider their punishment as suffering, for, content to do God's will, they are one with Him in pure love." —

There is no joy save that in Paradise to be compared to the joy of souls in Purgatory. This joy increases day by day because of the way in which the love of God corresponds to that of the soul, since the impediment to that love is worn away daily. This impediment is the rust of sin. As it is consumed, the soul is more and more open to God's love. Just as a covered object left out in the sun cannot be penetrated by the sun's rays, in the same way, once the covering of the soul is removed, the soul opens itself fully to the rays of the sun. The more the rust of sin is consumed by fire, the more the soul responds to that love, and its joy increases. The soul becomes like gold, that becomes purer as it is fired, all dross being cast out.

According to St. France is Sales: "The souls in Purgatory are most certainly there on account of their sins, sins which they have detested and still do detest above all things. Their pain arises from delay, from deprivation for a time of the blessed joys of Paradise."

St. Catherine, in her vision of Purgatory, saw that there is no gate between Purgatory and Heaven. But Heaven is so pure that the soul prefers to suffer the cleansing pains of Purgatory rather than enter among the saints with any stain of sin remaining. The Christian doctrine of Purgatory is truly consoling. Despite our present faults, in the end we will all be made saints.
