#### FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

The true way cannot be departed from.

Pope Francis and about three hundred bishops from around the globe are now in Rome for the "Synod on the Family." They are discussing the challenges that families are facing in today's cultures.

I am somewhat anxious about this Synod. Some highlyplaced Cardinals and Bishops have put forward proposals that are directly contrary to the Christian view of marriage and family. It shows that the Church is not impervious to the distorted values of our modern post-Christian societies — what Pope Francis calls "ideological colonization."

Nevertheless, I have supreme confidence in the Church. St. John Chrysostom said: "Nothing is stronger than the Church. It never grows old, but is ever full of vigor. Therefore Holy Scripture pointing to its strength and stability calls it a mountain." St. Paul calls the Church "the pillar and ground of truth."

There is an old Chinese saying that I came across a long time ago and on which I have often meditated:

The true way cannot be departed from.

The statement seems paradoxical but it applies to the Church: If we say that the Church was wrong in the past, then clearly it was not the true way. On the other hand, if it was indeed the true way, then it cannot be departed from and still remain true. If it was true then, it is true now.

Each age has its own particular ideologies, its own forms of intellectual and spiritual dysfunction — call it the spirit of the age, the *Zeitgeist* — Jesus simply calls it "the world": "If you belonged to the world, the world would love you as its own … but I have chosen you out of the world."

The Church has a wisdom that is above the "wisdom" of the world. St. Paul writes to the Corinthians: "If any one among you thinks that he is wise *in this age*, let him become a fool that he may become wise. For the wisdom of the world is folly with God." The Church is the custodian of that true wisdom which is a gift of the Holy Spirit and which does not change to suit every fashionable ideology.

The Church is often in the difficult position of defending herself against the pressure of being "updated" to adapt to the so-called "mind of modern man." In the past the call was for the Church to incorporate the "insights" of Hegel or Freud or Marx or whoever was the latest big name.

How different this is from the true Christian spirit: "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of you mind, that you may prove what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect."

G. K. Chesterton put it this way: "The Catholic Church is the only thing which saves a man from the degrading slavery of being a child of his age."

I thank God for Pope Francis and for the many faithful shepherds that He has given to His Church. May God give them the wisdom and courage to proclaim the truth of the Gospel without fear and without compromise.
