**FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:**

*The Rule of Faith*

I know that I have written about this before, but there seems to be a great deal of confusion not only in the mainstream media but even in some Catholic commentaries.

The Second Vatican Council declared that our "supreme rule of faith" is Sacred Scripture and Sacred Tradition. Together these form a single source of the Church's faith.

Sacred Tradition takes the word of God entrusted by Christ the Lord and the Holy Spirit to the Apostles, and hands it on to their successors in its full purity, so that led by the light of the Spirit of truth, they may in proclaiming it preserve this word of God faithfully, explain it, and make it more widely known.

The role of Tradition is not to *change* or *add* to the faith, but to *preserve* it faithfully and to pass it on.

What the media — and many Catholics — fail to understand is that the faith of the Catholic Church is not something that changes with the weather. It is constant and enduring. That is why the Catechism of the Catholic Church quotes Catholic sources from all ages.

So, where does the doctrine of the Pope's infallibility fit into this? It certainly does not mean that the Pope can change the Church's teaching. The document that defined the scope of the Pope's infallibility stated:

For the Holy Spirit was not promised to the successors of Peter that by His revelation they might make known new doctrine, but that by His assistance they might inviolably keep and faithfully expound the revelation or deposit of faith delivered through the Apostles.

The instances of the Pope issuing an "infallible" teaching are extremely rare. The last time was in 1950 when Pope XII defined the dogma of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin. Before that, in 1854, Pope Pius X defined the dogma of the Immaculate Conception.

Our faith does not depend on the Pope defining anything as "infallible." When the Pope issues an encyclical or other teaching he is not exercising infallibility; he is presenting what is already part of the deposit of faith and applying it to modern circumstances.

As Pope Francis writes in *Lumen Fidei* (On Faith):

The Church, like every family, passes on to her children the whole store of her memories. But how does this come about in a way that nothing is lost, but rather everything in the patrimony of faith comes to be more deeply understood? It is through the apostolic Tradition preserved in the Church with the assistance of the Holy Spirit that we enjoy a living contact with the foundational memory. What was handed down by the apostles — as the Second Vatican Council states — "comprises everything that serves to make the people of God live their lives in holiness and increase their faith. In this way the Church, in her doctrine, life and worship, perpetuates and transmits to every generation all that she herself is, all that she believes."
