**FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:**

*The Church from the Eucharist*

As we are now coming up to the 500<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the start of the Protestant Reformation, considerable ingenuity will be employed to obscure the real differences between the Protestant and the Catholic professions of faith. Surely, genuine ecumenism requires honesty on both sides.

For example, consider our differences regarding the Eucharist, the “source and summit of the Christian life.”

Martin Luther, the “father” of the Reformation, first set forth his reformed theology of the Eucharist in his book, “The Babylonian Captivity of the Church”:

Now there is yet a second stumbling block that must be removed, and this is the most dangerous of all. It is the common belief that the mass is a sacrifice which is offered to God. Even the words of the Eucharistic Prayer seem to imply this, when they speak of “these gifts, these offerings, these holy and unblemished sacrifices,” and further on “this oblation.” Added to these are the sayings of the holy fathers and the widespread practice uniformly observed throughout the world.

Over against all these things, firmly entrenched as they are, we must resolutely set the words and example of Christ. When he instituted this sacrament and established this testament at the Last Supper, Christ did not offer himself to God the Father, nor did he perform a good work on behalf of others, but, sitting at the table, he set this same testament before each one and proffered to him the sign. Now, the more closely our mass resembles that first mass of all, which Christ performed at the Last Supper, the more Christian it will be. But Christ’s mass was most simple, without any display of vestments, gestures, chants, or other ceremonies, so that if it had been necessary to offer the mass as a sacrifice, then Christ’s institution of it was not complete.

Luther states that the sacrificial nature of the Mass is “implied” in the prayers of the Mass, that this is the unbroken tradition of the Church since the “holy fathers” and that it is “uniformly observed throughout the world.” Yet he says that it is also contrary to the “words and example of Christ.” This conclusion is based on his view of the Mass as a re-enactment of the Last Supper.

The Mass is emphatically *not* a re-enactment of the Last Supper. *The Mass makes present the Sacrifice of the Cross.* The Sacrifice of the Altar and the Sacrifice of Calvary are one and the same! Abbot Vonier explains: “The Last Supper prefigured the sacrifice of the Cross; and the Christ who was to give His own natural Flesh and Blood that power of redeeming mankind, gave to the bread and wine the power of representing sacramentally that same Flesh and Blood.”

Pope John Paul II wrote in his encyclical, *Ecclesia de Eucharistia*, that “the Church draws her life from the Eucharist.” Genuine dialogue with our “separated brethren” is possible only if we hold fast to the truth of the Eucharist.

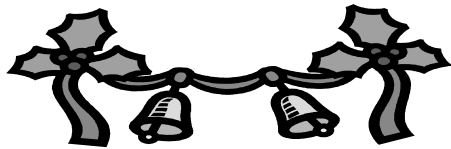
