#### FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

At the start of a new school year

I don't like initiatives! We should not have to re-invent our pastoral program every year. The challenge for us, as a parish, is not to come up with initiatives. We don't need new and better programs. We need to work on the program that we already have. As Pope John Paul II said: "The program already exists: it is the plan found in the Gospel and in the living Tradition, it is the same as ever. Ultimately, it has its center in Christ himself, who is to be known, loved and imitated, so that in him we may live the life of the Trinity, and with him transform history until its fulfillment in the heavenly Jerusalem."

So then, there is no question of a "new" program, but we do have to ask ourselves seriously: How can we better help each other to draw closer to Christ? How can we grow in our faith?

One of the truly hopeful signs in this parish has been the growth of our EDGE youth ministry. EDGE is for children in grades six through eight. EDGE combines play, music, teaching and prayer. It is all about helping our young people grow in their faith and in their love of Jesus.

In the face of the almost overwhelming influence of our secular culture, our children absolutely need to be involved in a youth ministry program.

For the first time ever, our parish participated this summer in the EDGE Adventure Camp — an amazing week of camp activities, catechesis and prayer. Our goal this first year was to have 10 children signed up — we had 18! Altogether there were around 350 EDGE children from about a dozen different parishes.

It is time for our parish EDGE ministry to grow. Starting Saturday, September 14th, instead of having EDGE twice a month, we will have EDGE every Saturday after the evening Mass. This will be a challenge for the parish. It will require a greater level of commitment. But as Pope Benedict has said — and I quote this often — "The world offers you comfort, but you were not made for comfort, you were made for greatness." This is not the time to settle for mediocrity.

The foundation for any parish ministry has to be prayer. I will state this categorically: Without prayer nothing good will happen in this parish. The one thing that is holding us back is lack of prayer. Prayer has to extend beyond Sunday Mass. It has to (as PJP2 said) fill our whole life. Otherwise we are not merely mediocre Christians, but Christians at risk of losing our faith.

To offer an opportunity for prayer, we will have a Holy Hour (Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament) every Tuesday at 6:00 pm, before the Tuesday evening Mass. If you care about your own relationship with God, if you care about the spiritual health of your family, if you care about the spiritual health of this parish, I strongly urge you to come and pray with us.
