



The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops has affirmed the recent Vatican Statement addressing the concept of the "Doctrine of Discovery," including the question of certain papal bulls of the 15th century which, according to some scholars, served as the basis for that 'doctrine.' Contrary to this claim, numerous and repeated statements by the Church and the Popes through the centuries have upheld the rights and freedoms of Indigenous Peoples; and Popes in recent times have also sought forgiveness on numerous occasions for evil acts committed against Indigenous Peoples by Christians. The new Statement further repudiates any concepts that fail to recognize the inherent rights of Indigenous Peoples.
