Unfortunately, the weather prevented many people from attending Mass, especially later on Sunday morning. The materials which were provided are still available, on the long table in the narthex. HOUSEKEEPING NOTES: Just a couple of things to note:

1) Did you know that, in the event of an emergency need to quickly exit the church, we have two doors behind the altar (these are the former front doors of the building---exit signs mark their location). All in the sanctuary area and the first 5 – 7 pews could exit that way, from either side of the altar area. And even those exiting through the current front doors could also divert into the Parish Centre, which itself has two exits to the outdoors. There would never be any need to panic.

2) As winter arrives, with colds and flus, some people have periods where they are uncomfortable shaking hands at the Sign of Peace, afraid of either giving something or of receiving it! If a nearby person just smiles and nods or waves to you instead of extending their hand, they are not trying to be unfriendly, just careful or thoughtful.
