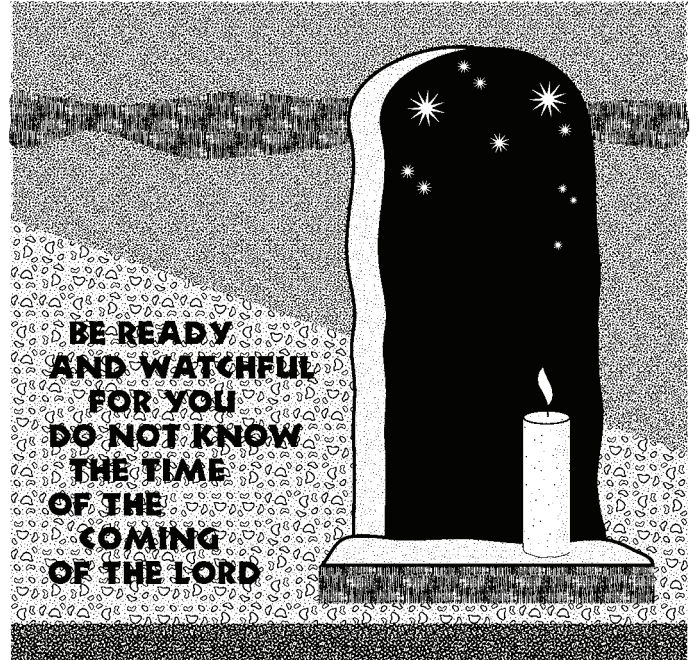

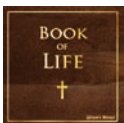


Sunday, November 18th

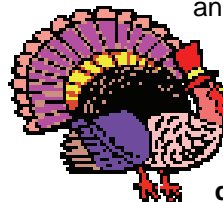

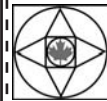
