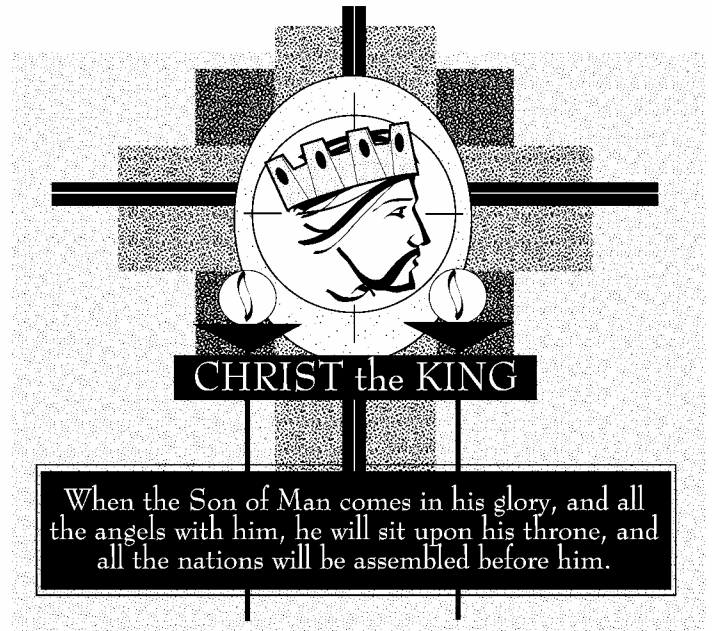
BAPTISMS – WELCOME!

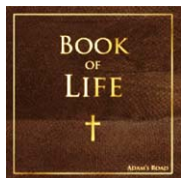

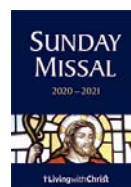
