We publish the following statement from the Diocese of Hamilton, as directed:



All employees serving in the Diocese of Hamilton are encouraged to be fully vaccinated or to submit to a COVID rapid test every Monday and Thursday in order to carry out their responsibilities. Volunteer liturgical ministers are required to be fully vaccinated. Bishop Douglas Crosby, OMI, encourages every member of the Catholic Church within our Diocese of Hamilton to be fully vaccinated.

Please note, to allay any confusion: At this time, there is $\underline{\text{NO}}$ requirement (provincial, regional, or Diocesan) for worshippers to be vaccinated in order simply to attend Mass or other religious celebrations in the church. Of course, the masking and social distancing requirements continue in force for the present.

MINISTRY TO THE SICK AND SHUT-INS


