**Sunday, Oct. 28<sup>th</sup> after 11:00 a.m. Mass**

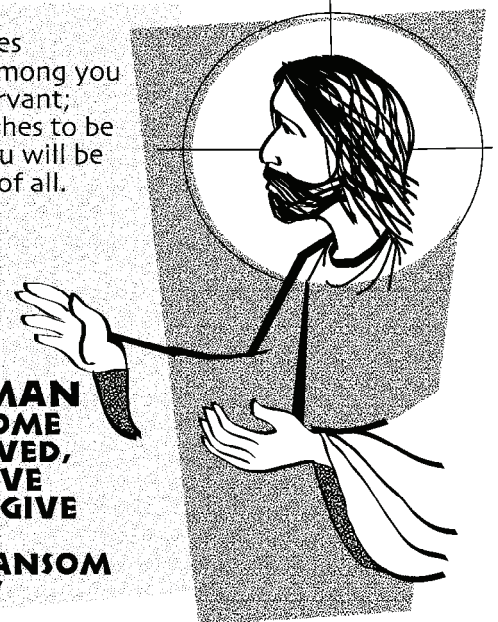

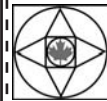
