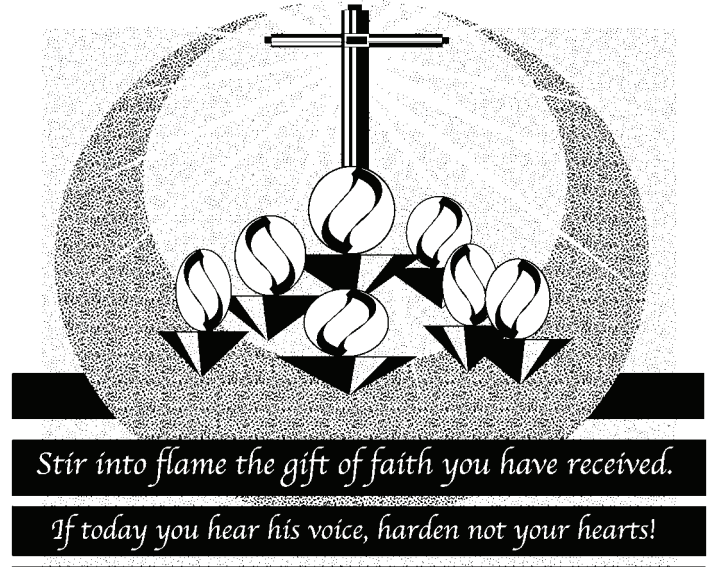

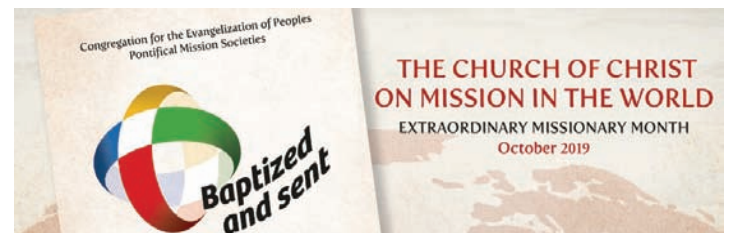

Reverend Mr. Stephane Zara was ordained as a Permanent Deacon for the Diocese of Hamilton in 2012. He is the husband of Luisa and father of three adult children. He works as a high school chaplain, at Ecole Secondaire Mère-Teresa in Hamilton, and is also the Moderator of Permanent Deacons for the Diocese of Hamilton. Deacon Stephane exercises his diaconate ministry of charity on a weekly basis, doing prison ministry at Hamilton Wentworth Detention Center, and serving homeless youth at the Good Shepherd. In general, Deacon Stephane will serve at our 11 a.m. Mass. He will also preach at all Masses about once every six weeks. Welcome!!
