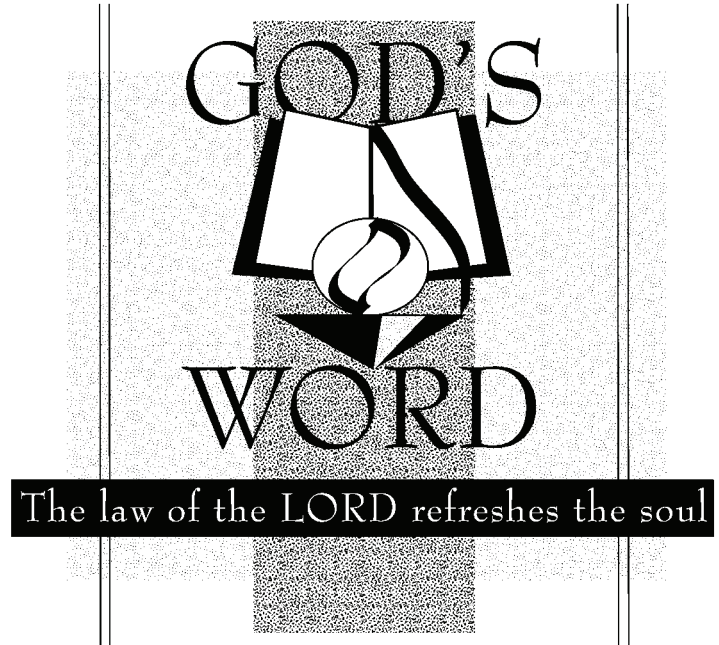

RESETTLEMENT COMMITTEE UPDATE

The Resettlement Committee met with the Director for the Office of Refugees for the Diocese of Hamilton in late August to begin the process of sponsoring a family. The Refugee Sponsorship Program currently has 150 families waiting to be matched. We submitted our application to sponsor a family on September 20th. Once it is approved, we will be matched with a family and we would expect to welcome the family to Canada within 3 months. Thanks to your generosity, there are sufficient funds to support the family for the first year under the Government sponsorship program. We will keep you updated on the progress of our application.
