I have to admit that much of the modern computer world is a big mystery. I joined Facebook years ago only to be able to keep an eye on certain younger relatives, to keep them on the up and up, to make sure that they weren't putting too much information on the platform, and to clean up their friends' language. In computer parlance, I think the word is creeping, and so I admit that I am a creep. I have made them change birthdate information, take down cell phone numbers, and yes, enlightened them to a more civilized vocabulary, worthy of having a priest uncle who visits their page on a regular basis. Things tend to pop up on my Facebook and I'm not sure how to stop themtoo many stories about dogs and as a non-pet advocate... who cares. As I explain to the children in the classroom when the question arises about my pet preference, I admit I love dogs, barbequed with mustard, ketchup (of course French's ketchup make with Ontario tomatoes), and onions. Anyway, an item from St. John's parish appeared one morning with photos of their Easter Vigil celebrations. I'm not sure how I got it because I have not 'friended' them. I must confess though, I was impressed by the number of people who were in attendance for the lengthy Easter celebrations. Of course it started me thinking about our celebration, this year, and the Easter Vigil in general. As my mind wondered through yet another meeting, I pondered how many Catholics had never in their lifetime participated in even one Easter Vigil. I know hundreds who have never been near one. When we acknowledge that it is as St. Augustine called it, the 'Mother of all liturgies", it is the absolute pinnacle of all our celebrations. It eclipses Christmas midnight mass by a longshot. The Easter Vigil is the ultimate celebration of our faith. No other liturgy comes close, except maybe the dedication of the Church. The Vigil expresses the best of who we are, and yet, the vast majority of Catholics will never experience it. It's a tragedy really. It speaks to a particular Catholic mindset, kind of a holdover from the medieval minimalism. Our Catholic culture has catered to the lowest common denominator. Statscan statistics tell us that a mere 16% of people in our parish who identify as Catholic attend Mass here regularly. That means that 84% of our first communion class we will not see again until confirmation time. That means that 84% of those young people baptized we will not see again until first communion time. Something is amiss. So the question rises, what does it mean to be Catholic? Church? Parish? Faithful? Eucharistic? Easter as a season



of resurrection demands that we reflect on what we do to support life as the Community of Faith. Maybe if we celebrated the mass on Facebook, we might become a trending topic.


