

Ruminations

Unlike Christmas, Easter really doesn't have any classic and enduring cartoons. For me, Christmas would not be Christmas without 'A Charlie Brown Christmas' (I'm sure no one is surprised by that) and the other favorite is Dr. Seuss' 'How the Grinch Stole Christmas'. These two stories are rife with meaning way above the age range to which they appeal. As I have been reflecting upon the upcoming Triduum (Mass of the Lord's Supper, Veneration of the Cross, the Great Easter Vigil, and Easter Sunday), there is not one particular celebration that stands out. There have been many memorable moments like my first Easter Vigil which took place at University, or the first time in a long time that the mission Church up north celebrated the Triduum (they all thought I invented the washing of the feet and the veneration of the Cross and the lighting of the Easter fire), or when my nieces and nephews all attended Easter Sunday mass with me. The Holy Three Days have always been my favorite time of Church year. There is just something uplifting and edifying by what the Church presents to us through these singular and unique rituals. It will certainly be a different expression this year, that's for sure – no feet to wash, no cross to pass over, no dunking into the baptism font, no young people parading through the congregation sprinkling the people, no glorious hymns, and no deacons singing the double alleluia at the end of Mass, thanks be to God. The Church will be very stark, and not just because the flowers and banners will be missing for the most part, but because this is one time when the Church is full, when many, many more people than usual make an effort to gather with us, and this year, we won't be there. Now every time I begin to think about it, the whole Grinch thing pops into my head. The most intriguing scene in that cartoon is when, after all the gifts and foods and decorations have been carted away, as the Grinch watches as all the little Whos assemble in the town square of Who-ville, undaunted by the seemingly stolen Christmas, they gather and hold hands singing away undaunted, that though the accoutrements of Christmas have gone, what is truly important remains. Christmas seemed impervious to the best sabotaging efforts of the Grinch, and this witness to the depths of the meaning transforms the Grinch and a small heart that grew three sizes that day. And perhaps this year more than most, we will gain a better



and deeper appreciation of the meaning of Resurrection, that after death, after strife, after tribulations, the promise of resurrection is offered to us every moment of every day. So as our gatherings this year will be necessarily limited and sparse, the important thing is that we are alive, surrounded by those whom we love, and we still celebrate a God who is with us still.
