#### **Ruminations...**

Twenty-six Sacred Triduum's under my belt as a priest. Perhaps that is why the belt has to get bigger each year, at least that is my excuse. They all kind of melt one into another. There have been many memorable moments that come to mind when reflecting on the beauty and rhythm of those holy three days, but specific times or dates are lost in the mists of experience. And anyway, there comes a time when we rise above the specifics or details and revel in the larger context. I suppose as a youngoops, I mean younger priest, the novelty of the first times dominate the memory, but now as a season veteran, the forest is more exciting than the trees. It kind of begs a question of what does success mean anyway. What is a successful liturgy? The only concrete tool we have is numbers of people or collection, but those are not valid indicators of a 'successful' celebration. Liturgy is all about transformation, and changes of heart, and deepening an awareness of the presence of God. Those are not measurable, alas. And sometimes the success of the liturgy is months or years down the road, a planted seed that may need much time to germinate and take root. All the ministers of the various ministries must be content with the knowledge that we put our best foot forward and the rest is up to the Holy Spirit and the openness of each and every individual who took the time to celebrate with us. These sacred rituals are there to augment a higher calling, our family gatherings, and so once the last prayers are prayed and the alleluias alleluia'd, it is time to celebrate with those so important in our lives. This Easter, my family, well those that were able to attend, assembled here. It is always a spirited event and as much as turkey and the trimmings had always been a mainstay around which the family gathered, convenience and efficiency have triumphed and our feast has become Chinese food from Dragon King in Holland Landing. It just makes life so much easier, and my apologies to all the turkey farmers, but the smorgasbord of food still gets gobbled up. When my nieces and nephews were younger, translate that to smaller, the rectory seemed bigger, but now that they are hitting mid-twenties with the youngest soon to join the ranks of teenager-hood, God help us, it seems that the rectory is smaller than of old. Sprawling young men take up a lot of couch space. This year was a bit sadder than other years. It is the time when growth measurements and milestones are marked for posterity. There was an inevitability about it, but I thought I still had time. Alas, the official measurement was taken and my young twelve year old nephew, soon to be thirteen, is sniff, sniff, taller than me. With mixed emotions, with pride and a certain amount

of sad resignation, it was a Happy Easter. So Jesus has risen, but so has my nephew, and for him, it was the heights of joy. 71. Roy




