Entering these last few weeks of summer, the excitement and anticipation of going to high school ramped up to a fever pitch. The Newmarket Era published the registration dates for the various high school grades. For my first year the registration for grade nines was on the Tuesday, exactly two weeks before the big opening. So mom drove me to the school which I had never been in before. I followed the signs to the school auditorium. It was like a great assembly line. You picked up your timetable, shuffled along to get your locker assignment and lock. Next you actually entered into the auditorium, and a senior student outfitted you with the various text books you would need. Back then we had eight classes every day. That meant that we were given eight text books and a few extra for English that we had to lug around the school trying to find our locker. Luckily my locker was just around the corner from the auditorium so at that point there was no climbing stairs with arms filled with books. Once we had paid our fees and locked the locker we were free to go home and fret about that first day of school. The timetable was kind of undecipherable – codes and numbers. The only thing that was easy to read was the room number of the classroom. It's too bad that as the first in my family to enter into high school that I had no familiarity with the education codes because it would have been that day that I realized that they had given me another 'R' Roberts timetable who happened to be in grade 12. For whatever reason there was no grade nine R Roberts schedule. It was so rare growing up to meet another Roberts who wasn't related so at the time I thought nothing of it. Come that first day of school though, as I walked into my home room, I realized that there was a mistake. It was filled with grade 12 students so I promptly went to the office. Now a school office on the first day of school is as close to actual chaos that I ever hope to experience. When I finally made it to the front of the line and tried to explain my situation, there was no time nor compassion. I was told to sit in one of two chairs at the office entrance. I sat there the whole day. The office had no idea why I was given the wrong schedule and there was no grade 12 student complaining about a grade 9 homeroom. Finally I was called into the guidance office where the councillor was much kinder. She too was astounded that there was no timetable available for me. The resolution was to go back and sit in the office chairs and return the next morning where they would have a schedule and a homeroom ready for me. That would mean that I would have to wait until everyone else was seated and then I would be relegated to the first empty seat, which as you can imagine, was always the front row. So in effect, my first day of high school was actually the second day. Sweet memories of the first day of school. *Jr. Roy*

Attention: Email Scam

In recent days, parishioners from a number of Archdiocese of Toronto churches have been targets of an email scam, similar to one orchestrated a year ago.

The scammer is creating Gmail accounts and using them to impersonate parish priests. Typically, the scammer emails parishioners posing as a priest and requesting gift cards.

Please be cautious when checking your email. Verify email requests for money or gift cards by phoning the parish at a known phone number (not a phone number listed in the email).

If you receive a suspected scam email from someone claiming to be one of our priests, please bring it to the attention of your pastor and ask him to forward the message to the Archdiocese of Toronto's Help Desk at helpdesk@archtoronto.org.
