

Ruminations...

Perhaps one of the consequences of global warming is not only the speeding up of the melting of glaciers and polar ice caps, but also the exponential increase in the speed of time. These two months of summer seemed to have been sucked into a worm hole and spewed us out on the cusp of September and the dizzying rhythms of our structured and scheduled lives. I am hard pressed to recollect any particular accomplish over these sweltering days of summer, let alone account for any of those planned projects that I promised myself I would do. That seems to be a recurring theme to my accelerated time lines of life- it just keeps going faster and faster. There were of course some minor things that got done, the partial cleaning of my office, the partial cleaning of the sacristy, the partial construction of the vegetable garden. That's the theme, partial... Anyway, when all is said and done, the one true highlight of the summer was the arrival of my long lost cousin from Alberta. Although I knew of his existence, I had never met him. Any connection was remote and by third party. My uncle would contact my dad for a yearly conversation but only passing references and peripheral details were exchanged. Mom and dad had traveled to the northern expanses of the Peace River district once and actually met my cousin. Now I am well aware of my maternal cousins. They were always part of our lives growing up, though now, more often than not, our reunions are governed by funerals. But even still, the intertwining of shared histories and relatives and stories was a grounding force. There was always a bit of a void, or something missing knowing that part of the bloodline was out there and the connection severed. So when my cousin drove up with his family, there was just an air of satisfaction, and as we sat down to share a meal, and we got to regal him with the stories of his unknown relatives, and showed him the farm and the houses and even the tombstones, there was a sense that the family was whole, even for those brief few days, and though there still remains a contingent of unmet cousins still out in the wild west somewhere. It was neat to hear his stories of my uncle and growing up in a log cabin without running water or hydro. It was interesting to hear about life with propane where the winters get cold enough to freeze the propane, or of bears wondering around the house, or of keeping the horses. It sounded so adventurous and exotic. Whatever else it did,



there is an unfulfilled restlessness that has been slaked, and the family seems more complete. Now they weren't wearing cowboy hats or anything, but my cousin is an ardent Edmonton Oiler fan, so maybe his trip here was not so much to see family as it was to visit the town where Connor McDavid grew up, but either way, it was great to welcome family home.


First Communion and Confirmation Registration
