Ruminations...

Whenever I think of Christmas, the first thoughts always turn to spending it out at the farm, with tobogganing, and over-sized Christmas trees, and the requisite Christmas gifts of towels and ugly shirts. As important as that may have been, the reality is that I have had more Christmas' away from the farm then at the farm. It is such a dominant motif that I tried to think when we stopped going to the farm for our family Christmas. Now many of you have likely driven over part of the farm. When the 404 highway was being expanded, part of the farm was expropriated for it. In fact, as you drive under the overpass at Bethesda side road, you are driving on what was our ski hill. The stand of humungous evergreens on the north west side of the road, I helped plant almost 50 years ago. When the highway finally opened, the caravan of cars created a somewhat toxic environment for my aging grandaunts who had grown up with the fresh pristine country air. The fumes were making them physically sick and the only solution was to sell the rest of the farm and move. They tried a condo in Thornhill, but when you are used to open fields and distant neighbours, well it seems even if you try to take the folks out of the country, you can never take the country out of the folks. It wasn't long before they moved back to Gormley away from the claustrophobia of city living. It was kind of a "Green Acres is the place to be" moment. We always thought of them as the old aunts, which since they were my grandmother's sisters, they were old, this pollution precipitated eviction aged them quickly. That was 30 years ago or so, and that marked the end of that segment of family Christmas tradition. Much has changed over the years, and things change. There have been important moments, the Christmas with the first grandchild, the first Christmas after dad died, the first Christmas as a priest (that is when it became a working holiday), but none of them were as formative as the ones growing up. Every Christmas since then is somehow measured or informed by those early days, and as much as we had great gifts back then, looking back they were defined more by with whom we spend Christmas, rather than what Santa delivered. And I must confess, that even as a 'professional religious person', as much as Church has been a part of that Christmas experience, and I have fond memories of Mrs. Middlebrook, my elementary school music teacher heralding midnight Mass at St. John's, Church, it has been a small part of the importance of Christmas. The reality is, Christ is being born in the midst of those family ties and Christmas is in service to them. This is not to undermine the importance of Church at all. I guess most of us of a certain vintage or wisdom gained by experience would recognize a similar outlook. Fr. Roy


