#### Ruminations...

Years ago I was out wandering through one of my favorite haunts in Ajax and my cell phone rang. Now perhaps it is a generational thing, but I am not an avid user of the new technologies. I have survived years without cell phones and perhaps my life patterns have developed in such a way that they are conveniences rather than necessities. I do not pride myself on the number of contacts on my list, and my preference is to use the phone more for emergencies than entertainment though I must confess I do like a good game of backgammon on my phone. So it is always a bit of a surprise when it goes off and so when I went to see who was calling (caller id. has to be considered one of the greatest inventions of all time) I was startled when it was my doctor. I had submitted blood work a few days earlier and had a pre-scheduled appointment to review the results. He was calling to move the date up, he didn't want to wait until the scheduled appointment. There is nothing like an emergency call from your doctor to kill a shopping mood. Anyway, he was concerned about elevated blood sugar levels, 'very elevated' as he put it. When I first discovered that I was diabetic, and that was over a decade ago, I had been able to keep it controlled by diet and exercise. Recently it has crept up and so I have been forced to go on medications which worked to lower the levels but not to acceptable levels, so I was referred to the diabetes clinic in the Tannery. The visit there was my first time and what a posh building it is. I kind of felt that I was under-dressed for admittance. So the diabetic experts have changed my medications and the caveat was that there might be side effects that will daunt me for about a week once I start them. The first one was expected, more frequent trips to the bathroom. The second one was light-headedness or foggy spells. I had held off starting the medication for over a month. I had too much happening to be foggy, and I still had ample reserves of the old medication. Anyway I started the new regime this past Monday. I took my first two pills after breakfast and everything seemed fine. I went out to celebrate morning Mass and in the middle, there was this rush of a buzz, of lightness and it became difficult to focus on the words, and my balance seemed to be a challenge. I felt like I was drunk, well what I think being drunk would feel like, being allergic to alcohol and all. As



the morning progressed and fog seemed to intensify a bit, but not in an unpleasant way. So if I seem a bit fuzzy, or unfocused, or like I am a bit lit up, truly it is an adjustment time to new medications that I hope regularizes my blood sugars, and if I am walking around with an idiotic grin on my face, you will know why. Living in a fog and loving it.
