

Ruminations

I feel like I'm training to become a hospital drama script writer. It has been quite a week at the hospital. Mom was finally moved out of emergency onto a floor. The floor is not exactly her section. She is placed on the floor with musculoskeletal ward – people with hip replacements and the like. So the diagnosis was indeed a urinary tract infection, eventually discovered to be caused by a kidney stone that was blocking the fluids from descending normally into the bladder. The solution was to insert a stent to bypass the stone. Easy peasy, right? The ten minute procedure was performed on Tuesday night and on Wednesday morning I was contacted by the doctor to let me know they had placed it in the wrong kidney so mom would need to go through the procedure again to remove the one and insert a new stent in the proper kidney. 


