I must say that as a priest, Valentine's day (and growing up we always called it St. Valentine's Day) has very little appeal. In fact, in the liturgical life of the Church, February 14 is the feast day of saints Cyril and Methodius, the missionary to the Slavic people and the developers of the Slavic alphabet, later to become the Cyrillic alphabet. The martyrology of St. Valentine is a little sketchy so he was removed from the universal calendar. No matter, it is still good business and a 'ludic' aspect of our faith. There is a liturgical concept that states that elements of ritual are designed to be 'ludic' meaning playful. For instance, a sprinkling rite like Easter morning, is playful by nature, and just because people may laugh and enjoy the playfulness, doesn't make it less holy or solemn or sacred. Though Valentine's Day has long ago lost a purely religious character, it still provides a fun dimension to our Christian identity. In elementary school, everyone always got a Valentine's card from everyone else. I can remember going to Woolworth's in the Newmarket Plaza to select the perfect package of assorted cards. The cards were basically a variation on hearts, cupids and bows and arrows, unlike today's profusion of superheroes and commercial cartoon characters. Not sure that I care if Cinderella wishes me a Happy Valentine's Day. While emptying mom's house, it was rather moving to discover that mom had saved all the Valentine's cards she received from dad for years and years. We had the decency to leave the cards closed and the private messages between mom and dad. With our kids' package, the hard part was matching the classmate with the appropriate friend. One certainly would not want to send a "love' card to the guys. Usually someone's mom would whip up a couple of dozen cupcakes topped with pink and red and white icing. In the upper years, it was an opportune time to have a lunchtime dance and we were invited to bring in record albums with our favorite songs on them to play while the gym lights were turned low and the one side of the gym wall was lined with the boys and the other side lined with the girls giggling at each other. My contribution to the D.J. table was my prized 22 Explosive hits from K-tel. Perhaps the term Valentine's Dance was a misnomer and it should have been called the Wallflower festival. All in good fun. And I guess that was the point that the whole purpose of the day was to break with the seriousness of everyday tasks, to leave the schedules and labours of the day behind for a while and indulge in some fun, some ludic activities. So whether St. Valentine is on or off the official calendar, whether it is no longer purely religious, whether



you get a Valentine or not. Enjoy some ludic activities, it's good for the Heart. Happy (Saint) Valentine's Day.


Our young candidates are becoming more insigntful as they reflect on the Sunday gospel and homily and how it relates to their


