

Back in the day, when I was in the best physical condition of my life, I was taking Judo, and jogging. There were nights when it was nothing to run 5 miles, and it was absolute freedom. There was a standard loop that was just over 2 miles and if I was feeling good, I would do a double or on occasion a triple loop. There were a couple of other roads that added variety. I would put on my Walkman, put in my favorite cassette with Huey Lewis on the one side and Bruce Springsteen on the other. I knew every song but I had my favorites. I loved the Boss's "Glory Days", not that I could relate to it all that well, because, if I look back at that time, those were the glory days Bruce was singing about. Who knew it at the time? That song suddenly surfaced from somewhere deep in my brain the other day as I watched all the families skating in Sharon arena at the Knights of Columbus Annual Family Skate. Whenever I walk into that arena, there is a great sense of nostalgia. I spent many a night there. I remember when the arena was first built and E.G. hockey moved from the Bradford arena to our own home ice. It is where I played most of my hockey. It was where I had my first official job as a ticket taker on Saturday mornings. It was there that I helped manage a hockey team. It is always like going to a familiar place. Well, watching all those young hot shot skaters zipping around, darting in and out, not necessarily trying to impress anyone in particular but just filled with exuberance and freedom, it brought back those days of yore, when life was carefree and fast. Since my operation I haven't been able to skate and it is only at the skating party that I have any laments about the limitations. As the young kids came up to challenge me to come out, or brag about their proficiency, part of me wanted to defend myself and explain that I was once a brash, show-off who could spin and twist and speed around that very rink. It was a fleeting thought, then it was gone. It was just so wonderful to see all the people, young and old, experts and beginners, families and young lovers, girls and boys out enjoying the cold and icy life at the rink.



So for all those speedsters who were seizing the day, breathe deeply for before you know it, as Bruce Springsteen reminds us, "Glory days well they'll pass you by, Glory days in the wink of a young girl's eye, Glory days, glory days". Fr. Roy


