Ruminations

I make no bones about the fact that I am a winter person. Beautiful fall days and sunny spring mornings are up there too, but as for summer, other than the extended hours of daylight and the long lingering evenings, I can't say that I am a fan. In the midst of winter blowing and snowfalls, you will never hear me longing for the hot, hazy days of summer. And the past week has only served to re-inforce my stance. If I had a nickel for every time I have wondered how we ever survived without air conditioning back in the day... I remember pooling money with mom to purchase our first air conditioner for fathers' day back in the mid-seventies from Zellers just after Upper Canada Mall opened. It was beyond a miracle. Until then, summer nights seemed unbearable. We had four boys in one room on bunkbeds, and the upper level beds close to the ceiling were like a blast furnace. Dad would turn on the fan for the furnace and we would all huddle around the air vent at night, sleeping on the floor, trying to endure the insane heaviness of the humid days and nights. We opened the window and put a screen in with a fan, but that only served to pump in the sultry air from outside. That is likely where I developed an aversion to hot weather climates, though I must confess that I have taken to thoroughly enjoying evening walks just around sunset and to be honest, I have encountered more skunks than mosquitoes. Most of the heat and humidity of the day have dissipated and with Bob Seger and Gordon Lightfoot on shuffle on my Ipod, there is a certain sense of tranquility to be found in the quieting world. That's the best part of summer. It has been way too hot for me to indulge in those tasks that need to get done. The only thing that seems to grow in this heat are the weeds. The grass has no real need to be cut, and despite the fact that our lawn is irrigated, the blades have been left at a respectable height. I have noticed an inordinate number of spiders this year, with webs and strands spanning almost any and all gaps on my patio. It has necessitated the carrying of a broom handle stretched out ahead of me whenever I go outside first think in the morning. This catches most of the strands and keeps the spiders at bay. Every once in a while I feel the invisible sensation of a wayward strand or the
