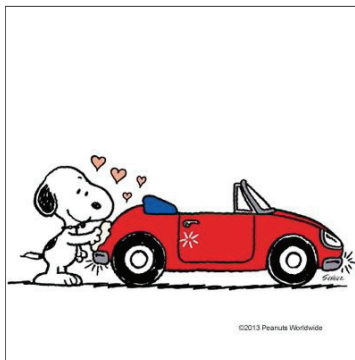

Ruminations...

Lent begins on February 14 in 2018. Easter is on April Fools' Day and Canada Day is on a Sunday. I only mention this because during the first week of July we sat down to put next year's calendars into print. We needed to arrange dates of parents' meetings, confirmation activities and first communion retreats among other activities, like a welcome back event in September, the ministry fair in October, and a whole slew of other things that happen weekly, monthly and annually in our parish. In essence, we have entered into summer 2018. It is a little unnerving to be dealing with next summer before this summer is underway.
