In our house, we considered Mothers' Day to be over-stated and Fathers' Day under-stated, which is exactly how my dad wanted it. The muss and fuss of preparing to spend Mothers' Day out on the farm kind of made for more work and less relaxation. Invariably the weather was nicer and there was always a tinge more excitement because the end of school animated every aspect of life. Mom's birthday was always just days after Fathers' Day so meal wise, dessert wise, everything was rather bland. If mom liked Chinese food for her feast, dad liked a nice ham and cheese sandwich- skip the mayo and the dessert. Sitting on the deck listening to the Blue Jays' game was the order of the day. Dad's ideal vacation would be if everyone else went away, not family, but the neighbourhood, the telephones, the television and any other distraction, though as reluctant as he was to travel out to northern Alberta to see his brother, he was as excited, if not more, about the wonder and majesty of Jasper and Banff. For him that was a once in a lifetime trip. Not that he would never go there again, but he could have died quite satisfied if that were his only trip. Mom and dad lived very simple lives with simple things and simple likes. There were no great vacations to far off places. Dad was a great fan of day trips, just so long as we could return home the same day and sleep in our own beds. The only real trips we took were for hockey or baseball, lacrosse or judo. Their one great pride (of course it goes without saying that their greatest pride was their eldest son) was the house. It is an enduring family story about the purchase of this house without ever seeing inside, the ridicule from family factions, and its subsequent transformation. Mom and dad would always remind us that they wanted the sale of this property to be a legacy. With great pride they would state that the house was to be divided by four equally. I guess this makes Fathers' Day a bit more poignant this year. This year, this week, all those hopes and dreams and pride of mom and dad come to fruition. The house has been sold and closed. the money has all cleared and each of the four boys, the eldest and the three also rans have all received a portion of that legacy, which would have exceeded all mom and dad's expectations. This is the



fourteenth year we have celebrated Fathers' Day in his absence, and unfortunately mom too is unaware of the gift they left us, but both would be elated to know that their little adventure over half a century ago has reaped such dividends. Not a bad way to celebrate Fathers' Day. Thanks dad.


Through your generous donations and together with St. John Chrysostom Parish the St. Vincent De Paul collection for May reached \$4,341.95!
