The end of June is always an ending of sorts. The school year draws to a close, parish activities slow down for a well-deserved hiatus, and it is the usual time of priestly transitions into new parishes. It is hard to imagine that it has already been five years since my last move. Time flies. This year's movement of priests seems personally a little more poignant. Our mother Parish, St. John's down the hill, is going through a big transition with the retirement of Fr. Bob and the leaving of Fr. Miro, both of whom have been there a long, long time, well beyond the normal tenure of pastor or associate. I first met Fr. Bob Ouellette back in 1987. My brother was assigned to St. Dominic's in Mississauga for his pastoral year and Fr. Bob was the pastor. It scares me to think that Fr. Bob was substantially younger than I am now, and we considered him one of the old priests in the diocese. Well maybe not old, but he certainly was of the generation of priests who were in their prime, and were the leaders that we younger priests looked up to. In the early days, whether at the priests' retreats or conferences, that generation of priests were truly the hub, and we younger priests kind of hung around the periphery picking up the stories of priests gone by, of antics in the seminary back in the old days, and of course the current gossip. It was a time when almost every priest knew every other priest. Those times are long gone and at our priestly gatherings, there are fewer and fewer of that stalwart generation who have weathered the storms and tides of the early post Vatican II years. There has been a tremendous influx of priests from away and so the number of priests who can speak of the often entertaining and colourful legacy of the diocese are in the minority. Home grown priests are becoming a thing of the past. Fr. Bob was well known for his boat. On every day off, and holidays, he would make the trip to Honey Harbour on Georgian Bay where his boat was moored. That boat was his baby, but I guess time takes its toll on people and boats, and the long commute and the costs of up keep and storage and mooring fees, it became easier just to go to Florida. Well, about 18 months ago, Fr. Bob got an app for his phone that could count down the days to his retirement. Every day he could tell you how many days were left until he relinquished his position as pastor. Well those countdown days have become countdown hours. His official last day is June 29 and then he can put his feet up. He did direct me to that app and for anyone who is interested in knowing, there are only 6,943 days until my retirement, but who's counting. Thank you Fr. Bob and happy retirement.
