



## Ruminations ....

It seems that when the summer weather wants to arrive it besieges us with a vengeance. I am so not a fan of hot summer days, but it is one of my favorite seasons, no not climate seasons, but sports seasons. It is track and field season. In high school I was a javelin thrower. Quite honestly I cannot remember a single placing though I know I did have a couple of first place ribbons. The fun was always getting a day off of school and spending a day in the thrill of the competitions, watching team mates win and lose, but cheering them on none the less. I never made it to the OFSAA (Ontario Federation of School Athletic Associations – don't feel bad, I didn't know what it stood for so I googled it), the pinnacle of high school sports. I loved when we had to travel to Birchmount stadium in Scarborough and Centennial Stadium in Etobicoke. Coming from a high school that had no track to practice, being in a real stadium with seats and everything made the event Olympian. And the variety of school track tops created a United Nations display of colours and flags. Well, I have been following my nephew through the various meets leading up to the provincial championships. Last week the York Region championships were held at a great facility at Bill Crothers High School in Unionville, with 46 high schools competing. They have a mini-stadium that is certainly above most high school tracks. My nephew was in throwing events which meant that I had to walk around the track to the other side. It was an exciting event. In this day and age, each high school has their own meeting tent erected around the track perimeter. They were all sizes and colours with the various school names blazoned across the roof of the tent, with piles of track gear, bags and athletes lazing around in anticipation of their events, listening to music, sleeping, eating or just plain chatting. It was like walking through a Medieval Carnival. There were names like Crusaders, Raiders, Magic, Eagles, Colts, Mustangs, Celtics, Thunderbirds, Spartans and the list goes on. It is a smorgasbord of things to see. Every time a starting pistol signals the beginning of a race, all heads turn to the track, and cheers resound encouraging the winners and the not-even-close-to winners. Shouts of encouragement usher the laggards to finish the distance races, which echoes the famous quote by Pierre de Coubertin, the founder of the modern day Olympics, "The important thing in life is not to triumph but to compete." The whole event itself is a great education, mastering skills, aspiring to improve, learning how to be gracious in victory and gracious in defeat. It encourages our young people to dig deep within and maybe even exceed their own expectations, filling them with a great sense of confidence and courage to maybe go beyond themselves. It is an opportunity to reflect what true victory is, not winning the ribbons or the medals, but the true triumph of conquering one's fears and failures. Therein lies the real victory. Citius, altius, fortius. (Faster, higher, stronger.) Happy Track and Field season.


