

#### **Ruminations...**

I remember the year that Secretariat won the Kentucky Derby. It was the second year that I had been recruited to cut my grandparents grass. Each week we would visit and it was my job to cut the small parcel of land, which usually took about an hour to complete. It was the first cutting of Spring, and contrary to the song, the first cut is not the deepest, it is the hardest. This year had been particularly wet and the grass was incredibly thick. It kept clogging the mower and stalling out. It was a frustrating day, and as I struggled through the front yard, I could hear the race being called through the open door and Secretariat cruising through this first leg of the Triple Crown. Anyway, at the end of the toil my grandfather had three crisp one dollar bills for my efforts. That was a huge payday back then. Then there was cutting the grass at home. Where my grandparents' lawn was flat, ours at home was sloped and framed with hills. Where my grandparents had no trees to serve as obstacles, ours was inundated with them. It took at least double the time and was infested with mosquitos. On hot summer days, it was a brutal chore. I couldn't wait for my brothers to grow old enough to help and take their turn. And the remuneration was only a two dollar bill and it wasn't even crisp. Years later dad wanted to assume the responsibility for the lawn upkeep so we pooled our money and got a riding lawn mower. After a couple of by-pass operations, it was the only way dad could do it. He loved zooming around, so much so that he extended the cutting swath to include a lower level of the property that was rarely part of our backyard engagement- again, mosquitos being a major deterrent. Well the impending transfer of the property this past week meant that we had to cut the lawn one last time. It was the first cut of this year and yes, the grass was thick and high. The riding mower had to be set for a high cut first and it took three rounds to work it down to a respectable backyard level. My nephews are certainly old enough and so they took turns on the tractor. The hills and sides required a bit more finesse and certainly the tracts under the trees that the tractor deck couldn't touch needed the push mower. It had been years since I had cut the hills. Because of road construction years ago, there is a five foot, 60 degree slope from the road to the front lawn that required brute force. So three hours later, we took a good long look at this marvellous piece of land, with trees we had planted decades ago, the hills that served as a great tobogganing chute, the field that served as soccer pitch, baseball diamond, red rover surface, javelin sector, a place



of exploring grasshoppers, snakes, snapping turtles, praying mantises, butterflies and birds, groundhogs and deer, and birds of every colour and song. It was a great place to grow up, and as Ecclesiastes reminds us, there is a time to let go. Whether we like it or not, this is the time.
