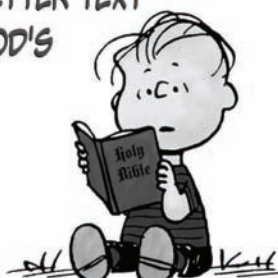

Ruminations...

It likely comes as no big surprise that I am a huge Charles M. Schultz fan, huge in the sense that I have much appreciation for his work, not huge referring to size. Over the years I have amassed a varied collection of memorabilia of the various characters. On my desk I have a wooden calendar of Snoopy typing on top of his dog house, and I assume it is as a kindred spirit creating his own Ruminations. It needs to be manually adjusted turning the numbered cubes to reflect the actual date and it is wonderful because as the days blur by, it is one way of being connected to the days and weeks and months that sometimes otherwise get lost or confused. There is a little Leprechaun that ensures that the doghouse is tuned to the right date each day. So it was quite a shock when I looked and saw that the date registered a June 1. Unbelievable. Now my date book should have been a pre-cursor. Many of our activities are slowing down to the usual summer hiatus. Last minute meetings and debriefings, and even planning sessions for the fall fill the evenings over the next several weeks, all before the onslaught of school graduations and closings. As we reflect on the year's work great conversations and insights arise. The discussions can be very enlightening, filled with laughter and concerns, memorable stories and poignant critiques. We had a wonderful debriefing with our Confirmation group leaders. This year it was a group of 23 leaders to accommodate the double cohort of candidates due to the Archbishop lowering the age for confirmation to grade 7. You can imagine the sophisticated algorithm required to schedule the date books of so many busy people. As a result only about half of them could make it. None the less the lively discussions and observations were free flowing. Now into the fray of the conversation was the very real statistic that 84% of those young people we will not see again for a long time. In the liturgical circles, authors often refer to confirmation as the sacrament of departure because the next time these newly fully initiated Catholics will grace our Worship Space is for the baptism of their first child, then maybe their marriage. It is a sad reality that really indicates that parents and children alike do not understand what they are participating in, and the integrity of a covenant commitment is lost somewhere in the translation of Church expectation and people's faith lives. But undaunted we acknowledged that faith is a gift that we do not give. It is the work of the Spirit and our task is to provide wonderful experiences where those who are open can encounter God through the witness and work of this community. As Scripture goes those who sow may not reap. So, as a community and as leaders I think we did a great job, and Spirit we are putting you on notice.....
