Ruminations

So the Thursday before our guest speaker arrived, the kitchen renovations were complete. The floor looked great, the moving of the stove opened up the space, and the portable island that I got on sale set the kitchen off as contemporary and functional. Friday was the day allocated to clean up the back yard just in case the weather permitted us to sit outside. After watering the gardens and the new flower baskets, I went back inside only to discovered that the kitchen floor had flooded but not in the same spot the previous flood was. We weren't sure where or why but we mopped up two buckets of water off the floor. There was no time to fret, only time to pray that whatever was going on wouldn't happen again until after the event on Monday. The weekend passed without incident, but on Monday morning it was time to get to the bottom of it. We suspected the outside faucet used to water the backyard was the culprit and indeed it was. The floor flooded again the minute we turned the faucet on. Maybe it was time to build an ark. Every towel in the house was commissioned to sop up the flood but at least the location was discovered. The frost free faucet was installed wrong and the pipes were exposed to the cold weather causing the pipe to burst. All the drywall behind the cupboards was soaked, and water leaked into the basement. The insurance people were here fairly quickly sending an emergency team to assess the damage and do what needed to be done. I was introduced to the head guy and I wanted to ask him if his mother knows that he's out past dark, and what grade he was in high school. He explained in his big boy voice, that it meant pulling down ceiling drywall, pulling up carpeting, cutting out wet drywall, and bringing in big noisy fans that sound like jet engines taking off, and dehumidifiers that have been on since Thursday. Thankfully there is a set of doors between the kitchen and the living room that muffles the sound to a dull roar. The dishwasher has been pulled out of its home and sits in the middle of the kitchen floor where the stove used to be and thankfully the portable island was portable and has been wheeled somewhat out of the way. The basement has become somewhat of a storage room with beds, desks, bookshelves, outdoor patio stuff and some of mom's furniture that I am hesitant to depart with all crammed into the space. There is even a full set of encyclopedia's down there. Then there was that horrific rainstorm on the weekend and the fear was that water would leak in from the corner like before. That is where the leaks had originated precipitating the last round of renovation. So I watched and watched for any hint of drops of water emerging from the baseboards.

Mercifully not a drop appeared. Rumour has it that the cupboards will all need to be pulled apart to get at the drywall and likely the countertop will be destroyed in the process. But it is wait and see. It always seems that one thing leads to another. There is still my bathroom that needs to be done, but I'm too afraid of what might happen. Maybe next year. *Jr. Roy*
